We would like to offer once more to our senior students French lessons for the new school year. Unfortunately, we are currently unable to include Spanish in our languages offer but are actively working to make it available as soon as possible.

The French school year will be structured in 2 terms, each of 14 weeks duration. Students will be organized in 2 groups: intermediate level for returning students and students with basic level of French, and a second group for beginners. Please find details below.

Term 1 will commence on Wednesday September 20th. Yveline Feval will continue teaching our students this school year. Yveline is a certified La Jolie Ronde teacher (<http://www.lajolieronde.ie>), fully Garda vetted, native speaker and with a vast experience in teaching French to children. Lessons are provided in a fun and relaxed environment.

Details of the new term:

- Classes will run every Wednesday, starting on September 20th until January 29th.
- **Book + CD** available for purchase directly from the teacher at a discounted price of €13 (normally €25).
- Please note it is parent's/guardian's responsibility **to collect their children at the end of the lesson.**
- **Eating is not allowed** during the lesson.
- The **total cost for the term is €90**. EPP will be set up for Term 1 in the coming days.
- There is a maximum of 12 students/class.
