Planning Ahead

In line with the Primary Language Curriculum a new English & Irish scheme will be introduced:

- 'Over the Moon' (Junior Infants to 6th Class)
- 'Abair Liom' (3rd Class to 6th Class)
- 'Hand-Writing Without Tears' (Junior Infants to 1st Class)
- 'Master Your Maths' will replace Maths Challenge
- 'Seesaw' school site licence
